## Smoke Alarm Safety Typs



Γ	Install smoke alarms in every sleeping room and outside each
L	 separate sleeping area.
	Install smoke alarms on every level of the home and consider extra
	alarms for larger homes.
Γ	Smoke alarms should be interconnected, so when one sounds, they

all sound.


Test all smoke alarms at least once a month and replace batteries

as necessary.

Keep smoke alarms at least 10 feet away from the stove to reduce false alarms.

Consider using special alarms with strobe lights and bed shakers for those who are hearing impaired or deaf.

Replace all smoke alarms every ten years.
